

Sara Irina Fabrikant's Biography

Sara Irina Fabrikant is a professor of geography, leading the Geographic Information Visualization and Analysis (GIVA) group at the GIScience Center of the Geography Department at the University of Zurich, Switzerland. Her research and teaching interests lie in geographic information visualization and geovisual analytics, GIScience and cognition, graphical user interface design and evaluation, including dynamic cartography. She is currently co-editing Frontiers in Visual Communication. She is a co-initiator and past co-director of the UZH Digital Society Initiative (DSI). Other service included an appointed membership of the Swiss Science Council (SCC) 2015-2023, vice-president of the International Cartographic Association (ICA) 2015-2019, and program committee co-chairing of the international AGILE 2008, GIScience 2010, and COSIT 2015 and 2022 conferences. In 2023, she received the Waldo-Tobler GIScience Prize by the Austrian Academy of Sciences.
